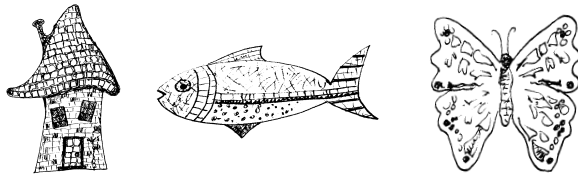


Heart Art Mosaics

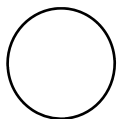
Mosaics are colourful, bold and unique. Create a stunning original artwork for your home or as a gift for someone special. (see website for pics) These artworks, like the mosaic Mirrors, are suitable for indoor and outdoors but not exposure to rain.

Base shapes and grout are black which shows off the vividly coloured glass. Shapes available are a Pixie House and a Fish (both approx 50cm X 33cm and a Butterfly (approx 46cm X 36cm) (see pics below). There is time for one of these artworks to be made in the blended 1 1/2 day Mosaic Workshop.

Fee is \$215. The dates and times are listed bottom right near the Mosaic Mirror.



Transparent Mosaics



Light and colour combine brilliantly in this art work. Participants will use transparent colored glass pieces to form a mosaic on a clear glass shape. Glass beads, glass frit, textured glass and crystal clear glue add new dimensions to the mosaic process. The base can be circular (25cm diam.) heart, teardrop or bird shaped. (Approx. A4 in size) Ready to hang in a window or outside, this lovely mosaic can be finished with glass beads and a crystal drop.

Fee \$140— includes tuition, notes, all materials, use of cutters, morning tea and lunch.

Mosaic Water Bowls, Table Tops, Wall Plaques, Pavers and Mirrors

This is a blended workshop. Participants are asked to indicate when they book in which project they would like to create. The specific materials will then be ready on the workshop day. All activities take 1 1/2 days. All projects use a wide range of beautifully coloured small glass tiles, the finishing grout will be black to enhance the colours, the mosaics will be suitable for indoor or outdoor use.

Participants will experience the direct method of mosaicing using whole tiles, cutting tiles and working with fragments. Each project allows for lovely, individual, artworks to be created while at the same time ensuring that the piece will be finished and ready to take home at 12 noon of day 2. (* Note that mosaics will need to be polished clean when they are dry.)

Comprehensive notes on materials, stockists, costs and process are given out.



Water Bowls are terracotta and measure 40cm in diameter.

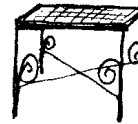
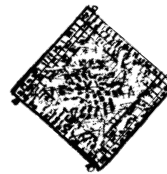


Table tops, Plaques and Pavers are all 40 cm square

Specially designed metal table bases (46cm high) and wall plaque frames are available in a black rust proof finish. Table bases \$95. Wall Plaque frames \$35.



Mirrors Three base shapes are available. a rectangle 55cm X 50 cm (mirror 18cm X 25cm) a Persian inspired shape, as illustrated below, 60cm X 40cm (mirror 16cm X 25cm) and a Heart 52cm X 48cm. (mirror 14cm x 14cm) See left. *Measurements are approximate.* These mirrors are not suitable for exposure to rain.

Fee \$215 Includes all mosaic materials, use of cutters, tuition, notes, morning teas on both days and lunch on Day 1.

Art For Well Being

This ongoing course explores imagination, story, symbols and the beauty of nature— all aspects of life which gladden our hearts, intrigue our minds and draw forth our spirit.

Ann leads playful, experimental 2D and 3D art activities that will build drawing skills, introduce painting skills, explore collage, printmaking and modeling, extend awareness of colour, line, tone etc., and give participants the opportunity to discover their own creativity and self confidence. Heirloom Eggs and Leaf Artworks

The beautiful shapes of many leaves are used to create surprising and delightful art on hen or duck eggs, paper and a stretched canvas in this “summer” workshop (see website for pictures)

The eggs can last 25 years as they are cooked in the dyeing/printing process. The colours and patterns are fascinating and the eggs are beautiful as Easter gifts or in a bowl as a table centre.

A similar process is involved, but on paper and stretched canvas, when pressed leaves, dye, paint and hot sunshine come together in a magical way – the resulting artworks are unique and lovely. Wish for a sunny day! and enjoy the beauty of nature in this workshop.

Note :- Duck eggs have the smoothest shells, if you know of a source, please phone Ann ASAP.

Abstract Acrylics

Artists acrylic paint is the best paint for expressing feelings and exploring ideas. It can be thickened, thinned, over-painted, transparent, opaque, glossy or matt. It dries fast and comes in luscious colours.

These workshops will give participants varied experiences with this versatile paint and a range of painting tools. Art works will be on canvas. Knowledge of colour, shape and texture will grow as they are used symbolically and as exciting starting points. There is no need for previous art experience, just a willingness to take inspiration from our inner and outer worlds and a desire to enjoy painting.

Weekly classes. 6 classes each term

Fee \$276 each term - includes paints, mediums, tools, brushes and equipment including one canvas board and one stretched canvas, tuition and morning tea. **Note** :- participants will need to provide additional small canvases during the term.

Abstract Acrylics and Collage days

Escape into art for a whole day – painting is fun. Acrylic paint is versatile, adaptable and forgiving, which is wonderful for us when we are evolving artworks.

The paint and mediums can also work like glue and varnish so acrylic paintings can hold words, photocopied images, fragments of fabric, leaves etc. In other words, acrylic painting and collage go together beautifully.

This year, “Collage for the Soul” is merging with Abstract Acrylics. These full day workshops give participants time to create a layered artwork, or one (maybe two) paintings as the six and a half hours is equivalent to two Friday mornings.

Three Saturdays offered each term – participants can book for individual or all Saturdays.

Fee \$96 for each day.—Includes one 30cm X 30cm stretched canvas, all paints, mediums, use of brushes and tools, tuition, morning tea and a “snack” lunch.

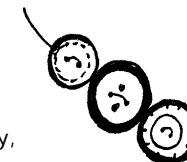
Button Jewellery

Have you noticed lots of lovely buttons about lately? Perhaps you have a button box full of buttons gathered over the years or inherited from your mother. This workshop of basic jewellery techniques and ideas for making necklaces, brooches and earrings using buttons, will have you creating your own wearable treasures or lovely gifts for friends.

Dyeing to Felt on Silk

This workshop combines fabric dyeing and two felt making techniques as participants create a beautifully light, soft, silk and wool scarf (finished size approx. 1.2m X 20cm) in their own colours and matching coloured felt ball earrings.

This is a new and extended version of the Featherweight (nuno) Felting workshop using a different silk fabric. The silk dyes come in a good range of colours and the dyeing can be vivid or pale, the results are individual and delightful (see website)

Mythic Masks

An imaginative workshop using a wonderful new modelling material, colourful or metallic paints and beautiful papers for collage.

Modelling and painting skills will be taught and then used as these fascinating faces are developed over the two afternoons. Ancient, exotic, fantastical, organic - each mask is amazing and quite powerful (especially when worn) and is a wonderful wall decoration. See website for pictures.

Silk Paintings

The technique of painting on silk is a delight for the senses. The dyes chase each other across the pearly, transparent fabric creating lovely currents of colour. In other places the gold and silver gutta lines hold the colour in pools reminiscent of ruby, sapphire and emerald jewellery.

There is time to play, experiment and refine skills on samples in this full day workshop, before creating a stretched silk painting (approx. 30cm X 30cm ready to hang) for your home. See website for pics.
